

RECENT MILESTONES

- Delays in reaching Financial Close for the Commercial Sector funding was highlighted to Members, and alternative options tabled to still target Q2 commencement of OMMP Stage 1;
- Receipt of Abstraction Water Use license (94 MI/day) for OMMP Stage 1 (Phase 2B & 2B+);
- Completion of the OMMP Early Works Contract 1;
- Formal support for the OMMP received from Lepelle Northern Water Board and Mogalakwena Local Municipality; and
- Approval of Budget Facility for Infrastructure (BFI) 1 & 2 funding for OMMP Stages 1 & 2.

MITIGATING KEY RISKS

- Delays to OMMP Stage 1, caused by funding finalisation challenges, can potentially be mitigated through grant and bridge funding to be released by Members; and
- Cost and schedule overrun risks will be reduced through a fully wrapped EPC NEC strategy, Member-led project control and world-class control systems and resources.

INDICATIVE MILESTONES

- Closing out of the Study Phase budget and Early Works Contract 1 by end of April 2025;
- OMMP Stage 1 EPC contract award with partial release by 10 May 2025;
- ▶ Completion of Early Works Contract 2 on 31 May 2025; and
- ▶ Gazetting of Amendment 2 to the Association's Constitution.
